The supplier / producer herewith declares to keep to the following points:

1. Specifications

Orders of the companies of the Beucke Group happen only on basic of the previously approved supplier specifications. The specification becomes with the approval a contractual item. Changes of the specifications must be announced by the supplier/producer immediately and without being asked. Only the supplier specification approved by the companies of the Beucke Group have validity for cooperation, after approval of the purchaser and particularly done of the content.

2. BSCI (Business Social Compliance Initiative) – Code of Labelling & Code of Conduct

The supplier/producer guarantees that the raw material delivered by him, and his subcontractors is exclusively from production sites meeting the internationally acknowledged social standards, especially those of the BSCI Code of Conduct concerning the country of origin



3. REACh-Regulation

If the product delivered by the supplier / producer falls in the area of application of the REACH order (the EC No. 1907/2006), he guarantees the adherence to all appropriate obligations, in particular that - if prescribed - all components of the product already were or will be registered according to the REACH EU-regulation.

The supplier/producer is obliged to provide the companies of the Beucke Group with all information needed to meet the requirements of the REACH EU-regulation in time and free of charge.

The supplier/producer is aware of the application of the supplied products at the companies of the Beucke Group. Therefore, as far as the supplier/producer provides the companies of the Beucke Group with a safety data sheet, the use by the companies of the Beucke Group must be named as an identified use according to the REACH EU-regulation.

The supplier/producer ensures that none of the supplied products contain ingredients being alarming according to the current and relevant SVHC register in its latest version.

4. Declaration of Conformity

The supplier/producer has for all packing materials, which are intended for the direct contact with food, to issue and send to the companies of the Beucke Group a certificate of conformity without being asked.
